- The AP material covered in the class will also help those who are taking the SAT Subject Test in U.S. History or World History in May or June. (Both tests are written by the College Board.)
- The APUSH curriculum has been freshly revised for 2016 because the APUSH exam was overhauled this past year and experienced significant changes.

Goal of the Bootcamp: Help students get a 4 or a 5 on the AP exam for admissions purposes and/or to receive college credit

Topics Covered:

- Multiple choice and essay strategies
- Test timing techniques
- FRQ and Short Response Question strategies
- Thesis writing and document usage
- Review lectures for the six major history units tested by the College Board
- Analysis/critique of real graded essays from previous AP exams
