

MOWR Admissions Criteria

MOWR enrollment earns both high school and college credit

- Must have at least 3.0 for Atlanta Metropolitan College (AMC) and 3.2 for Georgia State un-weighted GPA which means -- core classes only are considered.

Georgia State University

ACT/SAT scores can be submitted after application deadline date.

Student Eligibility

- Be a high school student seeking a high school diploma from a public or private school, including home study, or home school programs
- Be on track to graduate
- Be a legal resident of Georgia and meet U.S. citizenship requirements
- Obtain approval of the high school guidance counselor and parent(s)/legal guardian(s)

Admission Requirements

1. **GPA Requirement:** 3.2
2. **Test scores:** Students may take either the ACT or SAT. The following minimum scores are **required**:
 - ACT Requirement: 23 English and 23 Math
 - SAT Requirement: 530 Verbal (Critical Reading) and 530 Math
3. **Freshman Index (FI):** 2600 or higher

Application Deadlines

Applicants must submit the application, nonrefundable application fee, and required documents by the appropriate deadline.

Student Eligibility

- Be a high school student seeking a high school diploma from a public or private school, including home study, or home school programs
- Be on track to graduate
- Be a legal resident of Georgia and meet U.S. citizenships requirements
- Obtain approval of the high school guidance counselor and parent(s)/legal guardian(s)

Admissions Requirements

- GPA 3.0
- Test scores: Student may take either the ACT or SAT. The following minimum scores are required:
 - ACT Requirements: 20 English and 18 Math
 - SAT Requirements: 530 Verbal (Critical reading) 530 Math. Minimum 970 combined.

Applicants must submit the application, nonrefundable application fee, and required documents by the appropriate deadline.
